SANCTUARY CANDLE DEDICATION CHRIST IS THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Candles are used in worship as a reminder of Christ our light and the light in us that is His grace. They are also a symbol of His sacrifice. As the candle burns, it sacrifices itself in order to give light. When we light a candle, we make an offering for a particular intention. The candles that burn before the Blessed Sacrament in red globes are offerings to God for particular intentions. We have 2 week candles that cost \$20 and 1 week that cost \$10. Candle offering envelopes can be found in the votive candle stands.

PRE Registration



Registration for children's Parish Religious Education classes begins June 1 and ends **August 5.** Registration packets are available at St. Theresa in the vestibule. The Diocesan requirement is two years of parish religious education before a child may receive a Sacrament.

The Bible Timeline: The Story of Salvation

In this revolutionary approach to Bible study, presenter Dr. Jeff Cavins divides the Bible into twelve color-coded time periods that make it easier to follow its narrative thread.
