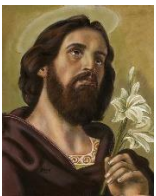
“Why We Worship: The Biblical Roots of the Mass”

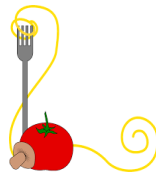


Come celebrate St. Joseph with Little Flower!
