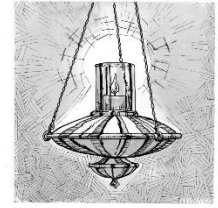

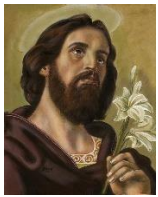

As we enter this Lenten season, please pray for our RCIA candidate, Ed Roberts, as he journeys toward the fullness of faith and communion with the Catholic Church.

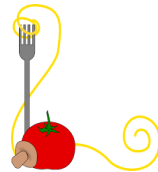


Come celebrate St. Joseph with Little Flower!
