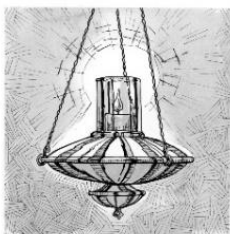

**Sanctuary Candle Dedication:** Christ is the light of the world. Candles are used in worship a reminder of Christ our light and the light in us that is His grace. They are also a symbol of His sacrifice. When we light a candle, we make an offering for a particular intention. The 5 candles that burn before the Blessed Sacrament in the red globes are offerings to God for particular intentions. Three of the candles (51% beeswax) last for 2 weeks and cost \$20. The other two candles burn for 1 week and cost \$10. Candle offering envelopes can be found in the votive candle stands or you may come to the office during open hours with your offering.
