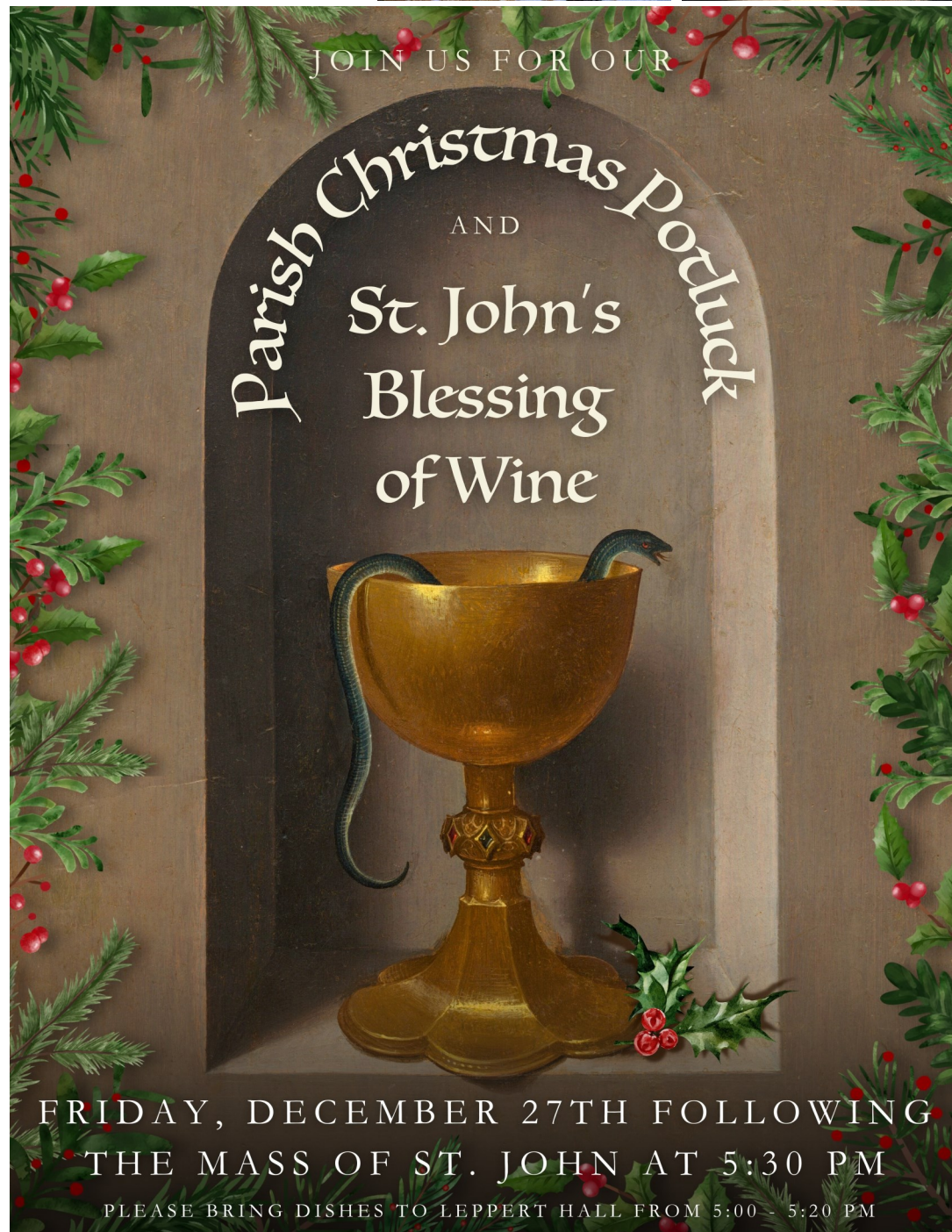
Infant King of Vocations Pilgrim Statue

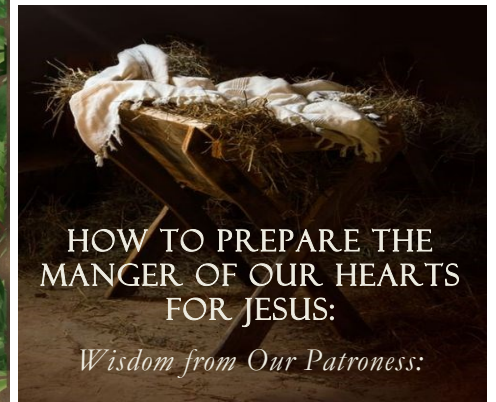
BELL RINGERS: If you would like to learn how to ring the new bells before Mass, contact Father to join the team of Bell Ringers.
